**Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-housing Program (HPRP)**

The Community Action Board (CAB), Senior Citizens Legal Service (SCLS), Mountain Community Resources (MCR) and the Santa Cruz AIDS Project (SCAP) are collaborating within Santa Cruz County to provide services to homeless County residents and people at risk of becoming homeless. The following services are being provided:

- **Gemma (CAB)** – provides assistance to homeless clients living in the Gemma transitional residence. For more information, please call 457-4560.
- **The Shelter Project (CAB)** – provides rental assistance to avoid eviction for families with children, seniors, and persons with disabilities. Please call 457-1741 Ext. 152 in Santa Cruz or 728-4634 Ext. 3 in Watsonville.
- **Senior Citizens Legal Services (SCLS)** – serves seniors who are at-risk of losing their housing and residents of Santa Cruz County mobile home parks, with information, referral and legal services. For more information please call 426-8824.
- **Mountain Community Resource (MCR)** – serves rurally isolated residents of the San Lorenzo Valley area with information, referral and case management services. For more information please call 335-6600.
- **Santa Cruz AIDS Project (SCAP)** – serves people with HIV/AIDS or at risk of HIV/AIDS with rental assistance, utility deposits and payments, and security deposits. Please call 427-3900 in Santa Cruz or 763-1374 in Watsonville.
